Each day includes breakout sessions.

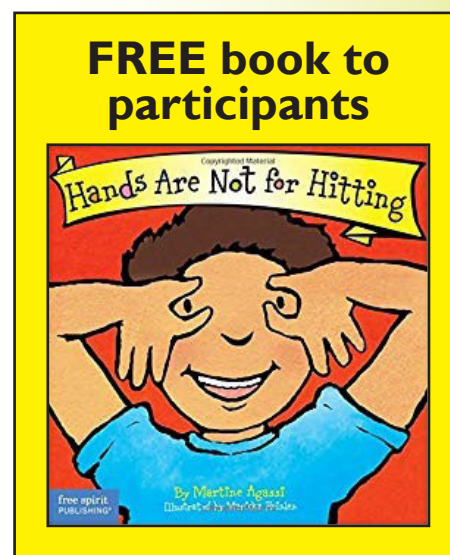
Topics include: Behavior Strategies, Math, Science, Phonological Awareness, Technology, Inclusion Strategies, and much more.
